3. The Plaintiff file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages on or before 23 August 2024.
4. Any intervenor in support of the Plaintiff file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages on or before 6 September 2024.
5. The Second Defendant file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages on or before 8 October 2024.
6. Any intervenor in support of the Second Defendant or who does not intervene in support of either party file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages on or before 14 October 2024.
7. The Plaintiff file and serve any written submissions in reply of no more than 5 pages on or before 21 October 2024.
8. The Plaintiff file and serve the joint book of authorities, in accordance with Practice Direction 1 of 2019, on or before 25 October 2024.

9. The parties have liberty to apply on three days' written notice.
