6. The defendants file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages by 4pm on 14 June 2024.

This order was taken out by the solicitors for the Defendants.

7. Any intervenor in support of the defendants and any intervenor who does not intervene in support of either party file and serve written submissions of no more than 20 pages by 4pm on 28 June 2024.
8. The plaintiff file and serve any written submissions in reply of no more than 5 pages by 4pm on 12 July 2024.
9. The plaintiff file and serve the joint book of authorities, in accordance with High Court Practice Direction 1 of 2019, by 4pm on 22 July 2024.
10. The parties have liberty to apply on three days' written notice.
