<b>Position</b>	<b>Chief Justice of Australia</b>
Envelope	The Hon <i>Full Name</i> [plus any post-nominals signifying a status, honour, or award e.g. AC] Chief Justice of Australia Address
Salutation	Dear Chief Justice <i>Last Name</i>
Conclusion	Yours sincerely
How to address orally	Chief Justice, but when on the bench, Your Honour

<b>Position</b>	<b>Current Justice of the High Court of Australia</b>
Envelope	The Hon <i>Full Name</i> [plus any post-nominals signifying a status, honour, or award e.g. AC] Justice of the High Court of Australia Address
Salutation	Dear Justice <i>Last Name</i>
Conclusion	Yours sincerely
How to address orally	Judge, but when on the bench, Your Honour

<b>Position</b>	<b>Retired Justice of the High Court of Australia</b>
Envelope	The Hon Mr or Ms ... [plus any post-nominals signifying a status, honour, or award e.g. QC, AC] Address
Salutation	Dear Mr or Ms or Mrs <i>Last Name</i>
Conclusion	Yours sincerely
How to address orally	Mr or Ms or Mrs <i>Last Name</i>
